

## **INFORMATION AND CONSENT REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF USERS OF THE CO. SCIENCE PROJECT WEBSITE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”)**

### **Premise**

The Italbiotec Consortium provides this information in relation to the processing of personal data collected by the Consortium during the visit and navigation of the website [www.coscience.eu](http://www.coscience.eu). This information is provided exclusively for the Co.Science project website and does not apply to pages or online services accessible via hyperlinks that may be published on the Co.Science project website [www.coscience.eu](http://www.coscience.eu). Personal data provided by users will be processed in compliance with Regulation (EU) No. 2016/679 (hereinafter “GDPR”).

### **Data Controller**

The Data Controller is the Italbiotec Consortium (Tax ID/VAT No. 02429600121), with registered office in Milan at Piazza della Trivulziana 4/A, represented by the legal representative pro tempore. PEC (certified email): [consorzio@pec.italbiotec.it](mailto:consorzio@pec.italbiotec.it)

### **Legal Basis for Processing**

The legal basis for the processing of data indicated in this information is the explicit consent of the data subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR, and the fulfillment of legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR.

### **Categories of Data – Navigation Data**

The Data Controller processes common personal data (name, surname, e-mail address, other personal identification data such as tax code, residence; navigation data such as IP address, URI/URL addresses, etc.). The IT systems and software procedures used for the operation of this website automatically acquire certain personal data during their normal operation, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected to be associated with identified data subjects, but by its nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified.

This category includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the site, addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the server response status (success, error, etc.), and other parameters relating to the user’s operating system and IT environment.

These data are used solely to obtain anonymous statistical information on website usage and to verify proper operation, and are deleted immediately after processing.

### **Categories of Data – Data Voluntarily Provided by the User**

The optional, explicit, and voluntary sending of emails to the addresses indicated and/or the completion of the form on this website entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data included in the communication, as indicated in the privacy policy related to the "contact us" service.

Except as specifically indicated above for navigation data and in the information provided pursuant to Article 13 GDPR in the individual sections of the Co.Science project website, the provision of data for further purposes is optional.

### **Cookies**

Information regarding cookies can be found in the cookie policy section. At any time, you can modify, revoke, or update the consent given in the cookie center on the right.

### **Purpose of Processing – Processing Methods – Data Retention Period**

The processing of your data using IT and telematic tools (and/or manual tools) is aimed at the correct use of the website regarding the services offered by the Co.Science project. Your data will be processed by the staff and collaborators of the Italtotec Consortium (internal or external, natural or legal persons) for service maintenance purposes.

Personal data are processed using automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected, pursuant to Article 5(e) GDPR.

Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, unlawful or incorrect use, and unauthorized access.

### **Categories of Recipients of Personal Data**

The data being processed may be communicated, in addition to the subjects referred to in the paragraph "Purpose of Processing – Processing Methods," to the judicial authorities when necessary to ascertain unlawful conduct.

### **Rights of interested parties**

With regard to the data processed pursuant to this information, you have the right at any time to:

-Access (Article 15 GDPR) – request and obtain from the Data Controller confirmation that your data are being processed and access to the data concerning you (including the purpose of processing and categories of data processed);

-Rectification (Article 16 GDPR) – request the Data Controller to correct, modify, or integrate your personal data;

-Erasure (Article 17 GDPR) – obtain the deletion of your data without undue delay (so-called right to be forgotten);

-Restriction (Article 18 GDPR) – obtain restriction of the processing of your data, e.g., to supplement the exercise of your right under Article 16 for the time necessary to verify the accuracy of the data;

-Data Portability (Article 20 GDPR) – receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used format to transmit them to another data controller;

-Objection to Processing (Article 21 GDPR) – object to the processing of your personal data.

### **Withdrawal of consent**

You have the right to revoke your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent prior to its revocation.

### **Complaint**

Pursuant to Article 77 GDPR, you may lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority in case of violation of the current data protection legislation.
